#### FOREWORD

As provided by Law N°31/2005 of 24/12/2005 relating to the organization and functioning of the National Electoral Commission (NEC) as modified and complemented to date in its articles 4 and 28 that the Commission yearly submits its Plan of Action and activity reports to the President of the Republic and a copy reserved to the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the Chamber of Deputies, the Chief Justice, the Prime Minister and the Minister in charge of Local Government,

It is in this context that the 2020-2021 NEC Action Plan was prepared. In line with implementing the 2017-2022 Strategic Plan, the focus of this annual plan of activities will be the preparation and conduct of "ABUNZI" Committees elections and Local and Special Councils' elections scheduled in Quarter 1 of 2020 and February- March 2021 respectively.

The key activities that will be carried out include mainly acquisition of election materials, update of voters' register, training of election volunteers and other election stakeholders, civic and voter education, general public awareness on electoral process and conduct of electoral operations.

The implementation of this 2020-2021 NEC Action Plan requires adequate resources, especially necessary funds to conduct timely and successfully the above mentioned elections. The budget allocated to the National Electoral Commission mounts to **Frw 3,513,887,791** showing a deficit of **Frw 2,208,605,897** compared to the needed budget of **Frw 5,722,493,688** for priority activities. The main gaps relate to the acquisition of election materials including printing ballot papers, the update of the voters' register and facilitation allowances of election volunteers on polling days.

The National Electoral Commission (NEC) takes this opportunity to express gratitude to the Government of Rwanda for the continuous support and calls upon all Rwandans and election stakeholders to actively participate in elections planned in 2020-2021 Financial Year.
